**ON INTENSIFYING PEDAGOGICAL AND
EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES OF MUSEUMS**

The Baltic Assembly,

understanding that exhibits of museums must become an active part of culture, historical memory, the system of education and patriotic upbringing,

being aware that in some fields of culture, e.g. ethnic culture, where the sources providing original folklore are disappearing, a museum often remains a single institution capable of taking over this function which ensures cultural continuity,

calls on the Governments of Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania to create conditions for intensifying educational activities of museums by developing the role of museums, so that museum collections - a living source of culture - become accessible to children and youth.
